## Mission Action Plan 2016-2019


This Mission Action Plan acts as a focus for our activity as a Benefice and Parishes for the coming three years. This booklet is an outline of what we have all helped shape – beginning with the 'Mission Priorities' identified at open meetings in early 2015, developed through everything we have done in the last two years, and clarified through the conversations that have taken place over recent months.

Through this process we have come to recognise where we believe God is calling us and so our Mission Action Plan will:

- Build on our existing response to God's call to us in this place.
- Respond to the Bishop's priorities of:
  - i. Growth in spirituality, numbers and missional commitment;
  - ii. Developing work with children and young people;
  - iii. Discovering the breadth and depth of lay and ordained vocation in your place.
- Develop what we do well together as a Benefice and celebrate what we do well as separate Parishes

To do this we will have **six** areas of focus; **two** shared by the Benefice, **two** in Haydon Bridge, and **two** in Beltingham with Henshaw.

Each area will be led by a group supported by the Vicar. By working this way we will all be encouraged to Discover the breadth and depth of lay and ordained vocation.


